- 2. Read Galatians 5:22-26. In what ways is God challenging you to walk what you talk?
- 3. How can we, as a church, work on and encourage one another in our faith that Jesus is Lord of **all** our lives?

Prayer ideas

- Praise God for the simple truth of the gospel of grace
- Spend time reflecting in prayer the ways in which the Lordship of Jesus may need to be more obvious in various aspects of your life
- Pray for courage, and a safe atmosphere of grace, for Christians to gently encourage and challenge one another in our Christian lives, and pray against an atmosphere of judgement and lording it over one another
